Are we going back to the future?

Welcome back Year 6! We hope you've had a lovely Christmas and wish you a Happy New Year! Throughout the term we will be working hard to provide guidance and resources to support you in every way possible. Here is an overview of some of our topics that we will be covering over the Spring Term.

History

Children will research the changes in transport, important inventions to develop transport methods and important people in history who have created our transport systems. We will also look at how transport may develop in the future.

RE

Children will be carrying out an R.E investigation exploring what is right and wrong within Christianity and Humanism. Children will identify and investigate values in human life, and think about their own values with special reference to Christians and Humanists.

P.S.H.E

Children will explore the theme of potential. Children will work on creating a toolkit for reaching their potential. They will understand what is needed to reach their full potential. During the second half term, children will look at independence and the skills required to become independent learners!

PE - Gymnastics & Dance

Children will be working on synchronisation and canon, understanding and explore the possible variations in level speed and direction, join together a series of movements then synchronise them with a partner to show knowledge of various partner relationships.

Science

Children will understand the importance of light including how it travels, how it affects us and how shadows are formed. In the second half term, children will look at electricity and carry out their own scientific investigation!

Music

Children will learn to appraise 2 pieces of classical music composed by Gustav Holst and George Gershwin. Children will research about each of the composers and the influences they had upon the musical world.

Art

Children will develop their art techniques, including their control and creativity. Children will acquire an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.
