

Terrific for Twos

Transition: We are really looking forward to getting to know the children, please don't worry if your child gets upset when you bring them to T4T's – it is normal, and they will settle with time.

Nursery rhymes: Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star, Incy Wincy Spider, Wind the Bobbin Up, The Wheels on the Bus. The children will be encouraged to use all of their senses as they explore and experiment with activities linked to these rhymes.

Stories: Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Three Little Pigs, Handa's Hen, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Jolly Postman, Dear Santa. – The children will develop their early literacy skills as they share books and stories with their teachers and friends.

Singing a wide range of Nursery rhymes and songs with your child.

Ensuring that your child comes to school every day and that they are punctual.

Reading a variety of books to your child.

Please make sure your child's belongings are labelled with their full name and that their book bag is in school every day.

This is an overview of the topics we will be covering over the autumn term.

Nursery

Transition: We are really looking forward to getting to know the children, they will be learning to familiarise themselves with Nursery staff, the classroom environment and daily routines, they will make new friends very soon!

Nursery rhymes: Baa Baa Black Sheep, Old MacDonald had a Farm, Five Little Monkeys, Incy Wincy Spider, 5 Little speckled frogs — the children will learn rhymes and songs and make the characters using their creative skills such as painting and 3d modelling, they will develop early counting skills and lean about colours and shapes.

Stories: Time to go to Nursery, The Naughty Sheep, What the Ladybird Heard, Handa's Surprise, Giraffe's Can't Dance, The Gingerbread Man, The Christmas Story. The children will develop their listening and attention skills, and their imagination as they pretend to be the characters from the stories.

Season's: The children will use their senses to explore the changing seasons and begin to develop an understanding of changes over time.
