<u>DT</u>	Writing
Research what a canopic jar is and what they were used for. Draw your design in your homework book and then create a model of one canopic jar. Use different materials and decorate it according to your design Teacher/Parent Signature	Research the Egyptian pyramids and then create a persuasive advert that will encourage people to go and visit the pyramids. Follow the instructions on how to mummify fruit. Draw a diagram in your books and write:	Research the ancient Egyptian social hierarchy. Which role would you like and why? Was it fair? You can write this in your homework book or use a laptop to type it up.

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Maths	<u>Art & Design</u>
Become a 'Rock Star' in Rock Star Times Tables. This can be achieved if you answer 20+ correct answers per minute. If you have already done this, aim for either 'Rock Legend' (30+ correct answers per minute) or 'Rock Hero' (60+ correct answers per minute) As we automatically get notified about your scores, you do not need to record this in your homework books. Research and write about hieroglyphics, discovering: what are, why they were used and the meaning of each symbol. Design your own hieroglyphic and write what it means. Teacher/Parent Signature
SpanishIn Spanish, the children will be learning the numbers 1 – 20 and the colours.For their Spanish homework, we would like the children to produce a poster showing a number of coloured objects.Can the children write basic sentences explaining how many coloured objects there are, in Spanish.e.g. Diez manzanas rojas = Ten red apples Teacher/Parent Signature	<u>Music</u> This term, the children will be learning about musical theatre.
