Geography:

During the term we will discover the continents and oceans of the world and then focus on the United Kingdom. We will use our map skills to identify human and physical features on a map, locating the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and look at different landmarks across the globe.

We'll also discover sculpture by looking at the work of Laurence Broderick and we will create our own animal sculptures using clay.

Science

We will be continuing our journey into summer by observing the seasonal changes. We will then move onto humans and animals by looking at the animal kingdom and learn about the types of movement and features of different animals. We'll also learn about our senses and how we use them every day. Towards the end of the term we'll be exploring light and dark and use our experimental skills to delve deeper into sources of light.

Design and Technology

For Design and Technology lessons we will research what bird feeders are available on the market and the various designs. We will then design our own bird feeder using a specification and create a computer-aided design. Using our design, we will then build a real bird feeder to bring home. Towards the end of the term, we will be looking at healthy foods and practise our cooking skills in the school kitchen.

Creative

Throughout our creative sessions, we will be learning how to use the gym equipment safely and practise our rocking and rolling skills to create a sequence of movement. In computing, we will be learning to program and build a short movie. In music we will take a closer look at the different musical families and try ourselves to play the new instruments that we discover on the way.

Topic

For our topic this term we will be answering the question: "Where are we from?" by learning about our place in the world and the different areas that make up the United Kingdom.
