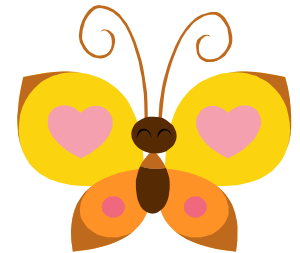

WHY MEET NOW?

- Plan ahead – time to make decisions.
- Plenty of time to start saving – pay over a period of time on SchoolMoney.
- The cost is £85.00. We will ask for a deposit to secure your child's place. 27th June. (£10)
- Payments to be complete by Friday 5th September.

1. To develop a team spirit within the year group.
2. To develop the child's independence and ability to care for her/himself.
3. To be able to explore the outdoor environment so as to learn about the world around them.
4. To have a challenge in a safe and secure setting.



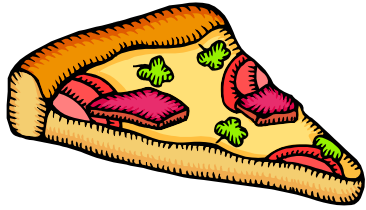
WHERE IS KINGSWOOD and HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

- Kingswood is an Infant only outdoor learning school, about 30 minutes from Bilston in Albrighton set in its own grounds which includes fields, woodlands, paths and small animals
- It is a safe site, completely enclosed.
- At night the site gates are locked, the doors are all alarmed and only the teachers have keys to the site
- Staff have mobile phones in case of emergencies.
- The caretaker lives near to the site and can also be contacted at night in case of emergencies
- NO OTHER SCHOOL WILL BE STAYING OVER NIGHT WITH US
- The cost of this year's trip will be **£85.00**
- **DEPOSITS of £10 IN BY 27th June please.**
- **Complete payments by 5th September. (SchoolMoney)**

WHAT ACTIVITIES DO THE CHILDREN DO?

- All activities, except the walk on the common are on site. The children do not leave the site except for the walk on the common. Activities include:
- Reading maps to find the treasure
- Making dens
- Going on trails through the grounds
- Exploring the different types of animals that are on the site
- Using equipment for bug hunting, using binoculars to find other wildlife
- Experiencing real life Anderson Shelters
- Playing with the play equipment in the school hall

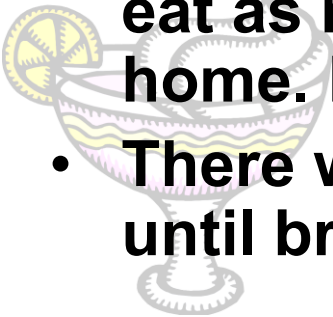




Food Glorious Food!

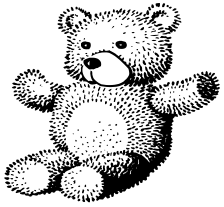


- **PACKED LUNCH TO BE BROUGHT WITH CHILDREN FOR FIRST DAY TEA**
- **DAY 1:**
- The children will have fruit and milk when they arrive.
- There will be a full hot meal and dessert at lunchtime.
- There will be a drink break in the afternoon.
- Tea is about 5.00p.m. Children will be encouraged to eat as much as possible! Sandwiches brought from home. Plastic bag to throw away.
- There will be a biscuit for supper, but no other food until breakfast the following day!



Food Glorious Food!

- **DAY 2:**
- **The children will have breakfast – cereals, toast, fruit and a hot drink as well as cold drinks.**
- **There will be a drink mid morning.**
- **There will be a cooked dinner at about 12.00.**
- **Please DO NOT pack any extra food for the children!**



SLEEP TIME!



- The children are kept as active as possible. They are ready for sleep!
- Kingswood has great bedrooms - colourful, bright and warm!
- The children are split into bedrooms – some larger bedrooms and some smaller bedrooms.
- Each room has a member of staff with them at all times
- Toilets are next to the rooms
- Children are asked to bring their favourite teddy with them to have with them at bedtime

TIMES, KIT LIST, MONEY

- Children arrive at normal school time and leave luggage by the Community Room. They then go on to the classroom as normal.
- They should be dressed ready for Kingswood, not in uniform.
- Children leave at about 9.45 a.m. on the coach/minibus.
- The luggage the children need is on a kit list. Your child will bring one home in the packs sent home with your child tonight.
- Children return from Kingswood for the end of the school day and will come onto the gate to be collected as normal.
- No electronic devices/ iPads / watches allowed.
- No spending money is needed.



KIT LIST

- Please make sure **ALL** belongings have your child's name in it!
- Outside waterproof coats are provided to go over your own child's coat
- Please make sure all toiletries are in a separate bag to stop other things getting wet!
- Don't buy everything new!
