Dear Parents and Carers,

Across the EYFS, we take part in "Fresh Air Fridays" (previously known as Outdoor Wednesdays). Outdoor Learning provides a wide range of opportunities to develop your child's confidence, understanding of the world, physical development, communication and problem-solving skills. Although we do provide access to the outdoor environment daily (no matter the weather), we have found that dedicating a day for outdoor activities and exploration has had a huge impact on the children's learning and development.

Our Fresh Air Fridays will begin on Friday 19th September.

On this day, we kindly ask that your child comes to school wearing a warm, waterproof coat with a hood, trousers or leggings, their school shirt, school jumper and their tie. **Please note that dresses and skirts are not appropriate to wear on this day.**

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing appropriate footwear such as **trainers or boots** (No Crocs or sandals). We ask that your child brings a pair of wellies (labelled with their name inside) in a carrier bag. The wellies will remain in school and will be sent home at the end of each term.
