At Wilkinson Primary School we take great pride in our appearance. A school uniform helps promote a sense of belonging and community. All children are expected to wear uniform at all times.

Uniform items can be purchased from a variety of retailers including supermarkets, locally from Bilston market and some items can be purchased from the school.

All children are expected to wear uniform as follows:

Girls Uniform requirements

- Grey skirt or grey pinafore dress
- White blouse
- School tie
- Green cardigan or jumper (optional logo cardigan/jumper available from school)
- Grey/white or black socks, tights must be grey/black or green
- Shoes black, plain flat heeled (no boots or trainers)
- Any coat (optional logo green reversible jacket available from school)

<u>Summer Uniform</u> – girls may wear a green checked dress (optional, available from school)

Boys Uniform requirements

- Grey short trousers (available from school) (Year 6 only wear long grey trousers)
- White Shirt
- School tie
- Green jumper (optional logo jumper available from school)
- Grey or black socks
- Shoes plain black (no boots or trainers)
- Any coat (optional logo green reversible jacket available from school)

<u>Winter Uniform</u> – All children may wear long trousers over their shorts/ under their skirts to come into school, these must be removed inside the school building, these can also be worn at lunchtimes.

PE Kits

- Green shorts (available from school)
- White t-shirt (optional logo t-shirt available from school)
- Black or green tracksuit bottoms may be worn in winter months
- Black pumps/plimsols for indoor PE (trainers only for outdoor PE)
- All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons.

Swimming Kits

Girls – One piece swimming costume & towel (optional goggles)

Boys – Swim trunks only no shorts & towel (optional goggles)

General

- No jewellery allowed except for watches and one small plain stud per ear lobe.
- No dyed hair or patterns cut in.
- No nail polish/false nails or makeup to be worn in school.
- Mobile phones and smart watches not allowed in school.
- Long hair must be tied up. A green headband, bobble and/or small hair clip can be worn.

Items which are available from school can be purchased via our online payment portal School Money, any items out of stock can be ordered.

When your child starts with us, school will provide their first tie in their house colour and a book bag free of charge.

It is advisable that all uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name, to prevent items getting lost.

The Role of Parents & Carers

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy and this forms an important element of our Home School Agreement. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed ready for their day and support them with their homework. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, that it is clean, in good repair and labelled with their child's name.

We have in school a stock of pre -loved uniform which can be purchased for a small donation. Anyone interested just needs to enquire at the school office.

The Role of Staff

All children are to wear the correct uniform. If a child comes to school incorrectly dressed, a telephone call will be made to parents to rectify this issue.
