This autumn term homework will be set for the children to complete in their homework books. Below is a list of homework tasks out of which 6 must be completed. It is up to you the order in which you want to do them, but one piece of homework needs to be returned to school on each of the following dates: **Friday 12th September, Friday 26th September, Friday 10th October, Friday 7th November, Friday 20th November, Friday 5th December.** For each piece of homework completed on time, your teacher will award you up to 2 Dojo Points, additional Bonus Dojo Points will be awarded at the end of half term. Outstanding homework will be awarded a House Point!

<u>Maths</u> Log onto My Maths using the username and password in your reading record. Have a go at some of the Maths activities. You can earn a certificate when you have completed a stage! For an extra challenge- can you research the Anderson shelter and stand up and tell the class all about it as you show off your fantastic model?
