What can we find from the Stone Age today?

Creative

In ICT children will create a Caveman game by using a programme called Scratch. They will create programmes to make their sprite move and later will create a class video. Throughout our PE sessions we will be exploring our bodies, stretching safely and making sequences. In our Art lessons we will be discovering what Cave paintings tell us and create our own. We will also use our engraving skills and use clay to create Stone Age pots. In music we will be learning about instruments from the stone age and how people

Design Technology

Many things have changed over the years. We will investigate and discover how houses have changed over time and why they have changed.

PSHE

Over the term, we will be focusing on families and relationships, and how to respect other people who are different to us.

History

Over the term, we will be discovering what we can find from the Stone Age today. We will be using primary and secondary sources, timelines and different artefacts. We will discover how the Stone Age people cooked and what they ate. We will find out how clothing became fashionable and what the different monuments were used for.

Science

Looking at rocks and soils we will discover and investigate how they were formed and look at their properties. We will be able to identify and name different rocks and find out how fossils were formed. After half term, we will understand how we see light and which surfaces reflect light. We will also find out how shadows are formed.

<u>RE</u>

Over the year we will be looking at the Christian faith and discovering who God is. We will be investigating what God means to Christians.
