Throughout this term we will be supporting the children to transition from the Early Years Foundation Stage into Year One. The children will be learning lots of new skills through a variety of adult led and child initiated activities around the topic of "Explorers". We are going to be completing a range of fun activities both inside and outside of the classroom that are outlined below.

Theme: Explorers

Below is an overview of some of the exciting topics your child will be covering this term.

Art: Digital Art: Learning to draw a fairy.

Weaving: Creating an Elmer mat.

Drawing: Drawing in the style of Quentin Blake.

Design Technology: We will be practising safe preparation skills to create a fruit salad.

Computing: Designer: Design an explorer doll.

Programming: Programming a Bee-Bot.

Music: We will be learning to compose a 4 beat rhythm, learn to listen and appraise pieces of music, and learn and perform a sea shanty.

PE: We will be learning to accurately throw and catch a ball, travel safely in different directions and using our bodies to create different shapes.

Science: Seasonal Changes: Identifying the four seasons, looking for signs of Autumn and discussing different types of weather.

Materials: Identifying different materials, making observations and comparisons.

The children will also be engaging in a wide range of Christmas themed activities towards the end of the Autumn term.
