We are OFSTED registered and work closely with other professional bodies in Wolverhampton to ensure that the care we provide is in line with Government Legislation. Breakfast and After School Club are an extension of the school day and therefore all of the school policies and procedures are embedded into clubs to ensure consistency.

We are committed to promoting the welfare and holistic development of all our children, which links seamlessly into our Breakfast and After School Provision. This service is available to all of our parents for a small fee (we also accept child care vouchers), whether they work, study or want an hour or two to themselves, enabling them to have the confidence to do so knowing that their children are well cared for.

We are very proud that our school has held Healthy School status for a number of years. To reflect this all the children are offered a choice of healthy meals and snacks. A full menu is available on this website.

At the start of each half term the children plan activities which they would like to do. These are displayed on our ideas board within school, all of which are initiated by the children and facilitated by our very enthusiastic staff in order to enhance and extend the children's learning. These activities are very flexible to suit the ever changing needs and moods of the children.
