Reception Induction



Reception Classes:

- There are two Reception classes RMW & RNRE
- Both classes are grouped together for RML, Maths and Writing sessions.
- During PE and busy time the children are able to free-flow between both classes and the hub area.

Uniform:

- Boys: grey shorts, white shirt, green jumper, grey/black socks, black shoes, and a school tie.
- Girls: grey skirt or pinafore dress, white shirt, green cardigan or jumper, grey/white/black socks or grey/black/green tights, black shoes and a school tie.
- PE Kits: green shorts, white short sleeved top, black pumps.
- Please ensure all uniform is clearly named.



Independence:

- It is important for the children to enter Reception in September able to complete simple tasks independently, such as:
 - using the toilet
 - washing their hands
 - putting on and fastening their coat
 - using a knife and fork



- Please provide your child with a change of uniform in case of an accident at school.
- Please encourage your child to be independent when changing at home, in preparation for PE.
- Ensure your child has their green bag in school everyday with their reading books and busy work.



Expectations of Behaviour:

- *High expectations of behaviour across school.*
- *Rewards: verbal praise, stickers, house points, Golden Apples and certificates.*
- *Behaviour chart: all children start on the green apple each day and can be moved on the chart dependent on their behaviour throughout the day.*



Attendance and Parental Involvement:

- It is important that your child attends school every day.
- If your child is unwell or cannot attend school please contact us as early as possible to let us know.
- In the early years, parental involvement has a significant impact on children's cognitive development and literacy and number skills.
